WHO WE SERVE

We serve residents of Piscataway, Dunellen, South Plainfield, Middlesex Borough, Edison, and Highland Park. Major programs of Fish, Inc. include food, clothing, blankets and bedding, provisions for Holiday meals, and Christmas gifts for children under age 12.

WHY WE SERVE

We follow the commandment to "love our neighbor." Services provided by Fish, Inc. are limited only by the availability of volunteers and provisions.

HOW WE SERVE

Hotline: All services are by appointment only through our Hotline, 732-356-0081, Mon - Fri, 9 AM to 5 PM. Volunteers assess eligibility for our services and schedule appointments. Walk-ins are not accepted.

Clothing Room: Families may receive clothing, shoes, and linens up to three times a year.

Food Room: Fresh meats, produce, canned goods, breads, and dairy once monthly. Clients must register.

Holiday Toy Program: Serves children of registered clients, up to age 12. Clients sign up in Food Room or Clothing Room.

Fishes and Loaves Cafés provide meals, hospitality and fellowship to any and all individuals and families twice monthly at two local churches for no charge. Café I, the third Thursday luncheon, is at Christ United Methodist Church hall on Hoes Lane. Café II, the third Friday dinner, is at Our Lady of Fatima Recreation Center cafeteria, New Market Rd, both in Piscataway, NJ.
